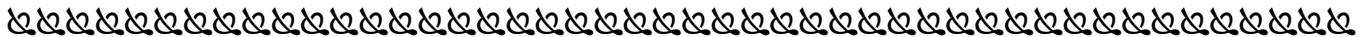

NCJW | MI AT WORK

The following is a list of NCJW | MI Community Service Projects in which you may choose to donate.

Advocacy and Election: Takes action on issues relating to women, children, and families through programming, letter writing, and other grassroots advocacy efforts at local, state, and national levels.

Adult Guardianship Review: Reviews assigned adult guardianship cases as liaisons to Oakland County Family Court.

313 Baby: A resource guide for women in Detroit who are pregnant or new moms.

Backpack Project 2023: Provides backpacks filled with school supplies for homeless children in Oakland County, as well as children in need in the Jewish community.

Back 2 School Store 2023: Provides a one-day event for Detroit students in need with the right tools for a successful school year. Each child will “shop” with a personal shopper for new clothing and a backpack filled with school supplies.

Children’s Advocates: Advocates for children requiring legal guardianship within the Oakland County Family Court system.

Education Assistance: Provides interest-free loans and grants to Jewish college students in cooperation with the William Davidson Jewish College Loan Program.

Israel Granting Program: Provides NCJW grants to Community Service Projects in Israel.

Jewish Youth Awards: Recognizes Jewish high school seniors with scholarships for their academic achievements and community service.

Kosher Meals on Wheels: Volunteers pack and deliver meals to the homebound in cooperation with Jewish Family Service.

Literacy Outreach: Provides tutorial programming and reads to elementary school students at Coleman A. Young Elementary School.

Programming: Provides educational programs for the community.

Safe Place: Provides temporary housing for women and their children due to domestic abuse situations in cooperation with Jewish Family Service.

Teen Yellow Pages: A resource guide on critical topics for high school students in Oakland County.

Wrapped in Love: Creates fleece blankets for children removed from their homes and placed in foster care, and for children receiving medical treatment in the hospital.
