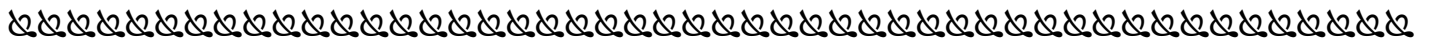

## NCJW | MI AT WORK

The following is a list of NCJW | MI Community Impact Projects in which you may choose to donate.

**Advocacy and Elections:** Takes action on issues relating to women, children, and families through programming, letter writing, and other grassroots advocacy efforts at local, state, and national levels.

**All Kids Playground:** A universally accessible playground for kids located at Hess-Hathaway Park in Waterford.

**Backpack Project:** Provides backpacks filled with school supplies for homeless children in Oakland County, as well as children in need in the Jewish community.

**Back 2 School Store:** Provides a one-day event for Detroit students in need with the right tools for a successful school year. Each child will “shop” with a personal shopper for new clothing and a backpack filled with school supplies.

**Children’s Advocates:** Advocates for children requiring legal guardianship within the Oakland County Family Court system.

**Comfort Care Kits:** Provides women with a comfort care kit following an abortion.

**Education Assistance:** Provides interest-free loans and grants to Jewish college students in cooperation with the William Davidson Jewish College Loan Program.

**Israel Affairs:** Provides programs to educate about Israel and NCJW’s work improving the lives of Israeli women, children, and families, including grants to fund Community Impact Projects in Israel.

**Jewish Youth Awards:** Recognizes Jewish high school seniors with scholarships for their academic achievements and community impact.

**Kosher Meals on Wheels:** Volunteers pack and deliver meals to the homebound in partnership with Jewish Family Service of Metro Detroit.

**Literacy Outreach:** Provides tutorial programming and reads to elementary school students.

**NCJW Green:** Provides programs to educate our community about global warming and steps each of us can take to improve our planet.

**Programming:** Provides educational and issue-based programs for our community.

**Safe Place:** Provides funding for temporary housing for women and their children due to domestic abuse situations in cooperation with Jewish Family Service of Metro Detroit.

**Wrapped in Love:** Creates fleece blankets for children removed from their homes and placed in foster care, and for children receiving medical treatment in the hospital.
